- Symptom management

Services NOT Covered

- Job Coaching
- Reasonable Accommodations

EPAS is part of a national effort to assist people with disabilities who want to work.

What is EPAS?

EPAS is a Medicaid service for people with disabilities who work. EPAS provides personal assistance to help maintain a job.

Who Qualifies?

A person must:

- ✓ Have a disability
- ✓ Receive Medicaid
- ✓ Have a job in an integrated and competitive setting
- ✓ Work at least 10 hours week
- ✓ Needs personal care to work

EPAS is not a waiver. There is no waiting list.
