

Employment Personal Assistance Services

A Medicaid service helping people with disabilities maintain work

What is it?

EPAS is personal assistance services for people with disabilities who are working, and, who because of their disability need personal supports to work. A licensed home health agency or qualified personal care assistant can provide EPAS at home and/or at work.

Who is it for?

EPAS is for people with disabilities, including those with a physical, mental, or cognitive disability.

Am I eligible?

You Must

- ✓ Have a disability
- ✓ Be eligible for Medicaid
- ✓ Have a job or job offer
- ✓ Need personal care assistance to work
- ✓ Work at least 40 hours each month

What is NOT covered?

- ✗ Job coaching, such as training or reminder to perform work tasks
- ✗ Reasonable accommodations your employer is responsible to provide
